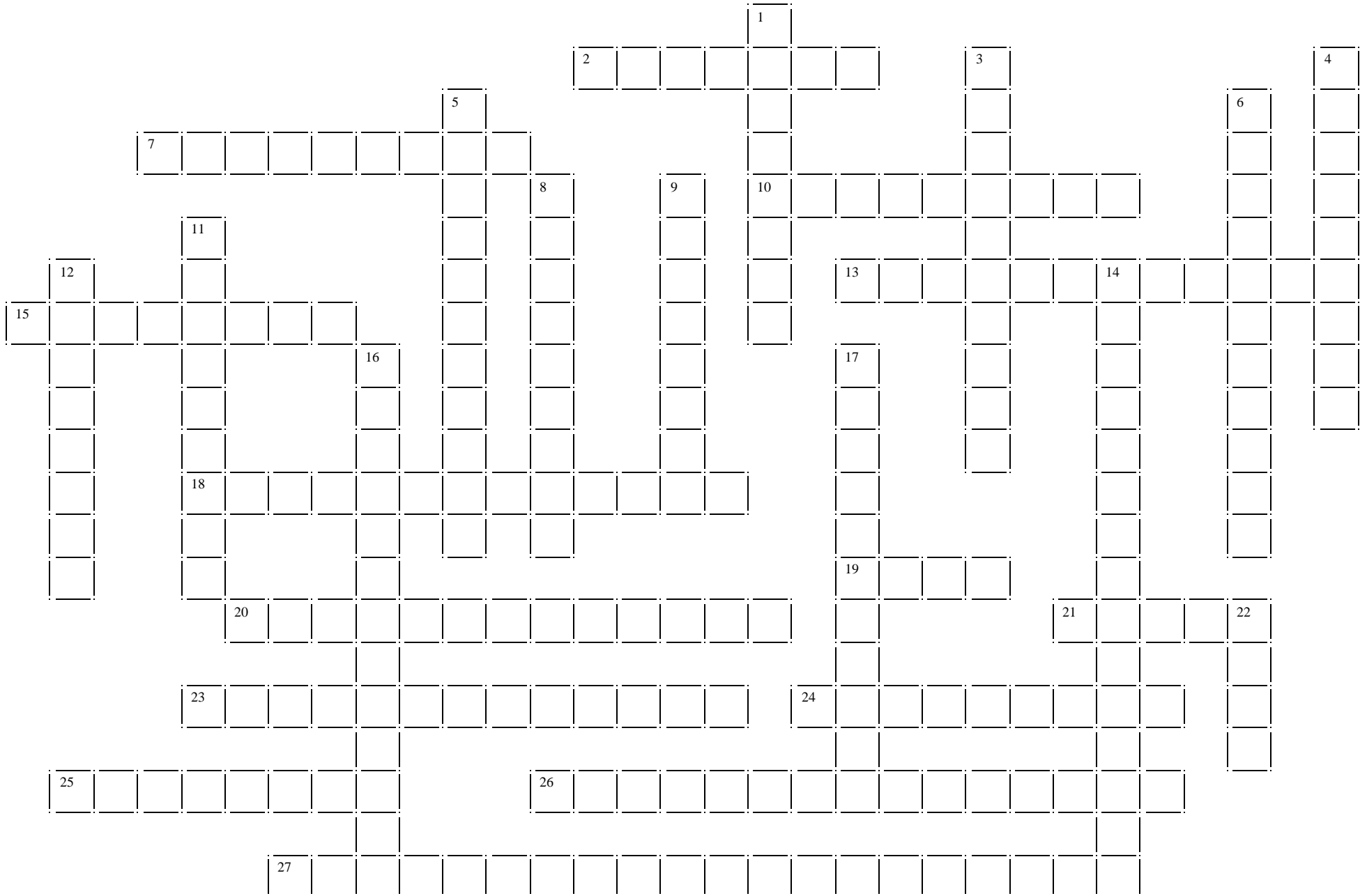


Treasure Island Vocab Puzzle 2

ACROSS
